Minimum of 8 years of program management experience specially in agriculture related projects. Experience of engaging with partner organizations. Experience contributing to the development of technical proposals. Experience in an international or governmental program would be desirable. Excellent written and oral English and local language. Prior working experience in USAID funded project would be added advantage.

Project Coordinator (1 Position-Based in Kathmandu): Bachelor's Degree in Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Horticulture or Rural Development (Master's Degree preferred). Minimum of 4 years of work experience in project support. Experience in the field of general agriculture, agribusiness and/or rural development for an NGO would be a plus. Experience in participatory action planning and community engagement, experience in monitoring projects and collecting relevant data preferred.

Monitoring Evaluation Accountability and Learning (MEAL) Senior Project Officer (1 Position-Based in Kathmandu): University degree in international development, economics, statistics or related field. Minimum 3 years' progressively responsible experience in MEAL. Ability to facilitate workshops, make presentations, and conduct trainings of MEAL topics for both specialists and non-specialist audiences.
