FHI 360, an international NGO, requests applications from qualified individuals under the United States Emergency Plan for AIDS Relief (PEPFAR)- and the United States Agency for International Development (USAID)-supported Meeting Targets and Maintaining Epidemic Control (EpiC) Nepal. EpiC Nepal is designed to break through remaining, persistent barriers to the achievement of epidemic control goals and promote self-reliant management of national HIV programs. EpiC focuses on filling existing HIV prevention, case finding, and treatment gaps, and on building long-term sustainability to attain and maintain epidemic control.

Consultant for the preparation of palika profiles and training database:
