FHI 360 Nepal requests applications from interested and qualified individuals to work as short-term consultant to perform a rapid qualitative assessment using focus group discussions (FGDs) and in-depth interviews (IDIs) among private healthcare providers/owners engaged with MOMENTUM Private Healthcare Delivery (MPHD) Nepal project supported by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) to review feedback received from the ongoing client feedback system and reflections of using the feedback to deliver client-centered services to adolescents and youth.

Consultant: Qualitative Assessment Expert

Key responsibilities:

- Prepare a detailed timeline to carry out a rapid qualitative assessment to capture private service providers'/owners' perspective on client feedback received through MPHD Nepal's client feedback system in consultation with the project team.
- Prepare a topic guideline according to the scope of work to conduct FGDs and IDIs.
- Lead FGDs and IDIs in the selected municipalities in Karnali and Madhesh provinces.
- Ensure transcriptions of FGDs and IDIs recordings and its quality.
- Analyze findings either manually or using qualitative software owned by the consultant.
- Prepare a detailed report and a learning brief for the project.

Qualifications:

- Preferred Master's degree in public health with at least five years of experience in carrying out qualitative assessment/studies/research.
- Previous work experience in conducting qualitative assessment or studies in a lead or co-lead role with government/NGOs/INGOs or as a job responsibility.
- Well versed in research methodology—design qualitative topic guides, data collection, analysis, synthesize, and prepare a detailed report.
- Able to analyze qualitative data using qualitative software like NVivo, Atlas Ti or manually.
- Good understanding of field coordination requirements to carry out a rapid assessment.
- Ability to write the assessment report clearly and concisely in English.
