



# **Overall Objective:**

The ultimate purpose of the assignment is to capacitate sponsorship team in identification, responding need, cross-sectoral integration, and design inclusive program to address specific needs of children with Disability.

## The key objectives of the assignment are:

- To deliver capacity building trainings on disability inclusion to sponsorship team and LGs.
- To support PNGOs and SC in screening of CwDs and recommendation for assistive device and services to needy children.
- To support PNGOs and SC in individual diagnosis of school at home children and provide necessary therapy support.
- To deliver capacity building training on disability inclusion to provincial duty-bearers and stakeholders.
- To support and work closely with LGs(local governments) to develop children with disability profile.
- To deliver capacity building training to resource school's teachers on inclusive education pedagogical practices in classrooms, especially sign language and brail training.

The OPD Resource Persons will work in close consultation with the Sr. Program Coordinator - Sponsorship Program after the commencement of the assignment. Sr. Program Coordinator will assure that the facilitators/experts from OPD deliver the sessions/tasks with the target clients of three sponsorship districts.


#### Location and official travel involved:

The OPD Resource Persons are required to travel to conduct trainings as well as for support visits at Resource Centres of municipalities across three Sponsorship Program districts (**Saptari:** Rajbiraj & Khadak Municipality, **Mahottari:** Bardibas & Gaushala Municipality, **Sarlahi:** Ishworpur, Haripur & Godaita Municipality).

#### Services the OPD will provide:

The assigned tasks will be conducted in Saptari, Mahottari and Sarlahi districts of Madhesh province. The main tasks and services to be provided by OPD are:

- Capacity building training to sponsorship team, Local Governments and Provincial duty-bearers
  and stakeholders on disability Inclusion: The technical experts of OPD will work closely with SCI
  Sr. Program Coordinator to define key contents of the training, prepare training schedule,
  produce resource materials and hand-outs, and deliver the training to participants as per SCI
  training standard.
- Screening of CwDs and recommendation for assistive device and services to needy children: The
  technical experts of OPD will work closely with SC program coordinators and PNGOs education
  program officers to initially screen children with disabilities, diagnose their key functional
  limitation and recommend necessary device and services to CwDs.
- 3. Individual diagnosis of school at home children and provide necessary therapy support: The technical experts of OPD will work closely with SCI and PNGO staffs to diagnose School at Home children's individual functional limitations and provide necessary therapy support to them and link them to organization/institutions providing such support.



- **4.** OPD work closely with LGs to develop children with disability profile: The OPD will work closely with LGs to conduct community-based disability screening camps to identify CwDs/PwDs, and support LGs to produce CwDs/PwDs status profile.
- 5. Capacity building training to resource school's teachers on inclusive education pedagogical practices: The technical experts of OPD will work closely with SCI program coordinator to define key contents of inclusive education pedagogical training, prepare training schedule based on sign and brail language content, produce resource materials and hand-outs, and deliver the training to participants as per SCI training standard.
- 6. Capacity building training on disability inclusion to provincial duty-bearers and stakeholders. The technical experts of OPD will work closely with SCI Sr. Program Coordinator to define key contents of the training, prepare training schedule, produce resource materials and hand-outs, and deliver the training to participants as per SCI training standard.




