- Strong experience in project management including assessment, planning, implementation, budgeting, monitoring, and reporting.
- Familiar with up-to-date poverty eradication strategies, child rights and protection policies, and development practices in Nepal and outside.
- Experience in leading and managing projects through a local partner NGO.
- Skilled in coordination and networking with local and district stakeholders.
- Experience working in remote areas in cross-cultural environments.
- Good communication skills both speaking and writing in English and Nepali.
